- Fluorescent Tubes and lamps (All types)
- Electronic & Magnetic Ballasts (*Non-PCB only. Must be post 1978*)
- Capacitors
- Bare Tube CRT
- Refrigerators, Freezers, most water coolers, some dehumidifiers
- Fire Extinguishers
- Mercury Containing Devices (Thermostats, Ionization Smoke Detectors)
- PCB Ballasts
- Styrofoam
- Wood

**Accepted TERRACYCLE items:**

- used dental items such as toothbrushes, empty toothpaste & dental floss containers
- empty cosmetic/personal care containers such as lotions, tubes, bottles, pumps, lip balms, lipsticks, makeup, deodorants, soap, shampoo, plastic caps
